## **Parents Right to Know**

Each year districts comply with the Parents Right-to-Know requirements of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act or ESEA by notifying them of their rights to request the following specific information concerning the school and teachers. Information that is available to parents upon request is:

- Whether the teacher has met Kansas qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which Kansas qualification or licensing criteria have been waived;
- The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree; and
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
- Their child's state assessment scores.
- The school and school district state reports cards. They may be found at www.ksde.org.
